n a few minutes he will captivate and amaze the audience like never before.

WELCOME THE MENTALIST.


The kind of magic he is about to perform is unlike what people are used to. He deals with the magic of the mind. The borderline between imagination and reality is a fine one and over the course of the show he will take his audience on a journey across that border. There are no props, smoke, mirrors, or tight leather pants – this is mentalism in its rawest, finest and purest form. Before going on, think of any double-digit odd number from 1 to 50, but make sure it is made up of two different odd digits. So, something like 13 would work, but 11 would not.

What is mentalism and is there really a When the two come together. the outcome can be unbelievable. There exists many patented mechanical masterpieces which aid performers: boxes which seem opaque but in reality are completely transparent, tools that let you discern what is written down on a piece of paper 50 feet away. Most of these are designed by people with a scientific background and armed with a brilliantly creative mind. Mentalism is also a performing art; some call it a subset of magic, while others prefer to consider it a separate domain. Practitioners are known as mentalists and their routines could involve mind reading, mind control, clairvoyance, psychokinesis and suggestion. The acts are usually highly theatric and present the illusion of mind reading. However, everything must have an explanation, right?

In all likelihood it does, but the greatness of a performer lies in his ability to suspend the disbelief of his audience.

The human mind is a wonderful but untapped mystery that always springs serendipitous surprises upon human beings. Science is progressing fast, unraveling the mysteries that surround this blisteringly quick and powerful organ. Magic and mentalism take advantage of the lack of knowledge on this front and play around by crossing the boundaries of reason and cognition. Performing is not simply about mastering the technical aspect of effects; it requires a very good understanding of how the human mind works. Mentalists do not depend on anything supernatural, but their presentation could suggest such abilities. It usually involves leading the audience to mismatch the cause and effect, to form one false hypothesis after the other.

The mind is intelligent but also easy to lead astray. Think about young children being lured by chocolates. As time goes on, this tendency to be distracted by sweets is overcome. However, there are many more ways to direct or redirect a person's attention — and that's the powerful technique known as misdirection. With simple, directed gazes, carefully timed gestures, and verbal cues, a performer can literally pull his audience around like they're on a leash without them realizing it. Yet,a good artist will not leave his audience feeling like fools, but leave them in a state of wonder and amazement after experiencing something that they never thought possible. And once they realize it, that's when they're completely blown away, when the mentalist tells them that the number they were thinking of was 37n.

ABOUT MIND READING

The truth is that is doesn't take that many skills to read minds.

All you need is the drive to learn and the willingness to lean on your intuition when it tells you what someone is probably thinking or feeling at the moment.



In this book Tony Corinda explains about the illusions and tricks (both simple and complex) with the actions to be carried out behind the scene. The book is recommended for anyone who is older than 12 years. The book is beneficial for a beginner and professional alike. You may find this book a little old fashioned which makes it difficult to read because it was written in 1961. If you are an aspiring mentalist, this book is a must. You will understand why it is considered among the best mentalism books.



MENTALST OR MAGICIAN

The MENTALISTS usually don't combine "typical" magic tips and their psychological feats. Which means that they would connect mentalism directly with the theatrical performance "hocus-pocus" practiced by podium magicians. Most mentalists affirm they are not magicians at all, saying that it is a completely distinct technique. The reason is that Mentalism requests perception and when exposed correctly, it is promoted as being "existent" be it an example of mental potential or evidence that can support other examples including a photo memory, being a personal computer, the strength of suggestions.



The Magicians invite the public to change their perception and let their creativity to have fun with a variety of techniques they offer; they accept that they are tricksters and artists and the public realise that the girl actually is not cut in two pieces nor could the entertainer really fly or maybe making remarkably huge elements disappear. . . it is everything an optical illusion. But there is a "go over" regarding both of these ideas identified as "Psychological Magic" — repercussions containing sensation of things paranormal or maybe emotionally extraordinary even so include a set of physiological systems that give to the people a possible justification associated with "hocus-pocus".





A lot of magicians, associate psychological abilities with secret optical illusions. This type of magic performs are usually described as mental power by entertainers.

Cocult / mentalism / magic

Old reading in one of the fundamental skill sets for an aspiring mentalist. In this section i am going to show you 3 ways to cold read. Like everything it is going to take a lot of practice to get good at it but its definitely one of the skills you need if you want to know how to become a mentalist.

The term 'cold reading' refers to strategies used by mentalists and by fraudulent psychics and mediums to give the impression that they can psychically discern personal information about a client.

The reading is 'cold' because it does not depend on any prior knowledge of the client.

Cold reading is a classic trick traditionally used by "psychics" but does has it's place in mentalism if you so desire. You can use elements of cold reading in your act. Cold reading generally works by using carefully crafted language and paying attention to your subjects responses. It can also be used as a mind reading trick




Instead, the 'psychic' combines careful observations of the client's characteristics and behavior with a series of guesses that are based on deduction, knowledge of probabilities, and use of general ('Barnum') statements that are readily accepted by large numbers of people as being true of themselves.



DERREN BROWN (born 27 February 1971)

is an English mentalist and illusionist. ... In his performances he often expresses that his magic tricks are achieved through purely psychological means. Brown does not claim to possess any supernatural powers and his acts are often designed to expose the methods of those who do, such as faith healers and mediums. In his performances he often expresses that his effects are achieved through "magic, suggestion, psychology, misdirection and showmanship.

Brown was born in Croydon, Greater London to Chris and Bob and has a brother nine years his junior. Brown was privately educated at Whitgift School in South Croydon (where his father coached swimming), and studied Law and German at the University of Bristol.

While there, he attended a hypnotist show by MARTIN S TAYLOR, which inspired him to turn to illusion and hypnosis as a career. As an undergraduate he started working as a conjuror, performing the traditional skills of close-up magic in bars and restaurants. In 1992, he started performing stage shows at the University of Bristol under the stage name Darren V. Brown (the "V" is for Victor)



He has predicted the Lottery and is banned from every casino in the land. But illusionist Derren Brown says he only got into magic to counter his shyness at school. ... Illusionist, trickster, magician; call him what you will – even "Derren", which by some mind control technique he's managed to convince us is a real name.







Brown came out as gay in 2007, and is in a long term relationship with a designer. He came out late in life—his parents were not practising Christians, but they sent him to Bible classes from age 5, believing it was the right thing to do. In an effort to deal with issues of self-esteem and sexuality, Brown became a committed Evangelical Christian in his teens in order to present a confident, asexual, character. By his twenties he had decided that his belief in Christianity had no basis, and became a committed atheist. He turned to the character of the eccentric, caped magician to fulfil the role.

Since 2004, Brown has been the patron of the registered charity the Parrot Zoo Trust in Friskney, Lincolnshire. In an interview with LeftLion magazine, he said, "I'm a big fan of parrots – I think they're fascinating creatures. Many of them live for longer than us humans and it's interesting to me the way they learn to mimic human voices even though they don't really comprehend what they're saying


Who was he? Did he really know?


His real name was CLAUDE ALEXANDER CONLIN (1880-1954) and he was one of the premier mind readers of all time. He was called a crystal gazer by some, a con artist by others and he admitted to killing at least four men in his lifetime. He began his career in show business around 1902 by doing a magic act. Not just any magic act though. Part of his act was an escape act basically copied from Houdini. There were many performers ripping off Houdini at this time and work for no named escape artists was pretty thin.

He gradually added material to the show including a levitation illusion and several girls to the show. As fate would have it, one night in 1906 on his way to a show in a blizzard, his props did not arrive. Alexander the Magician was livid, there was a show to do and no props. An assistant suggested he do his mental and mind reading tricks so he collected up some bits of paper and pencils and all the small assorted things he would require to do a mind reading act.

It was a huge hit and really a night that changed his life. He discovered that he did not need the enormous props and showgirls. He could do a solo act with mind reading and it actually went over better than his regular act. Alexander had been looking for something in which to make it big, and the accident of his lost luggage was a blessing in disguise.

Alexander did continue to do his escape act on occasion. A review of his escape act was covered by Leonard Hicks in the Conjurers Monthly Magazine in 1907. If you recall from a previous blog of mine, Leonard Hicks was Houdini's protege and the only man besides Dash authorized to do Houdini's act. Hicks was also the Chicago reporter for The Conjurers Monthly Magazine, which was owned and published by Houdini. Hicks's coverage of Alexander's escape act was not complimentary, but even if it had been the greatest escape act in the world, that would not be printed in a magazine run by Harry Houdini.







his brief description doesn't really come close describing Alexander though. During his career his was often in trouble with the law. He escaped from jail on more than one occasion, not as part of his act but from actually being locked up by the police. He was considered a dangerous and wanted man by many policemen across the country. As stated above, he admitted to killing four men, one of them possibly the legendary Soapy Smith of Alaska.

He was a friend to Harry Kellar & Floyd Thayer but not friendly with Houdini. He was a very unique and one of a kind individual in the annals of magic history. His story is worth checking into. There have been two books written about Claude Conlin. His story is superbly covered in a book called "ALEXANDER THE Man Who Knows" by David Charvet and John Pomeroy. There is a second biography "The Life And Times of Alexander, The Man Who Knows" by Darryl Beckmann.

I also heard that the 1937 movie "Eternally Yours" starring David Niven and Loretta Young is loosely based on the life of Alexander. I've not seen the movie so I can't say for sure. But I'll be hunting it down now to see for myself. One thing is for sure, ALEXANDER THE MAN WHO KNOWS HAS A LIFE STORY that belongs on the silver screen!



This series of articles starts with one of the most fascinating stories in the history of magic, let alone mentalism. Alexander's story is surrounded by intrique, controversy and a mixture of fact and fiction (much coming from Alexander himself).

Here was an average magic performer, copying acts from other magicians including Houdini's escape act, striving for successful formula; he eventually and almost accidentally found fame and a considerable fortune as the world's leading mind-reader. Here was a very driven, focused individual. whose strenaths included a very good grasp of human psychology, remarkable understanding of marketing and promotion, a financial astute mind to enable him to profit from his successes and taking ideas from anyone and anywhere to create what was one of the most successful and profitable acts of its time; a performer rigging a stage with underground wires to receive electronic signals in the 1920s, concealed using earpieces under his turban, and hidden listening devices in the toilets of theatres to gain vital information to be used later in his shows. Add to this a serial adulterer. with up to possibly twelve marriages, bigamy, a suspected murder, money laundering, grand larceny, fraud and drug smuggling, a significant FBI dossier, Alexander's life was nothing but dull. He is the original man of mystery and his story is simply incredible.

NEW THOUGHT & Spiritualism beliefs

orn from Irish immigrants in a small town called Alexandria (In Hason County in the Dakota territory, US) on 30 June 1880, Claude Alexander Conlin became a master of his trade long before many other performers saw the potential of a mind-reading act he was (although also influenced by the success of Anna Eva Fay and Sammi Baldwin). He was the son of a doctor, Berthold Michael Joseph Conlin (affectionately known as BMJ) and Martha Johnson, and grew up mainly in southeast Alaska. Within the family Claude Alexander was known as "CA." and his brother Clarence B. was known as "CB." Clarence B. had a successful career as an attorney and also worked as a stage mentalist, although his fame never equalled that of his brother Claude.

As an adolescent boy, Claude spent much of his time hunting and fishing, passions that remained with him throughout his life. Travelling shows visiting his town and regular trips to the magic section of his local library (where he discovered Hoffman's Modern Magic), fed his curiosity on the mysteries of life (as too did the revealing pictures of women found in his father's medical books) leading to an early fascination with magic (and women); after being expelled from school at 17, he decided (against his parents approval) to travel east and by chance found work at the most famous spiritualist resort of Lily Dale, near Cassadega, New York. It was here that the young Claude's education into his future career really took hold.



During his work as a boat-boy and cleaner he discovered the fraudulent ways of the mediums, learning how they did their slate writing, billet switching, spirit collars, rope ties and other tricks spiritualists. More the importantly he discovered the psychology of the psychics, which allowed them to turn simple effects into supposed miracles performed by spirits. Presumably considering career in magic, after leaving Lily Dale, he visited T.Nelson Down (the "King of Coins") on his way 'west'. His nomadic instincts led him to the Alaskan gold rush where a long term friendship with Greek a Immigrant, Alexander Pericles Pantages began; it was during his time here that he was suspected of shooting swindling gangster Jefferson Randolph 'Soapy' Smith, who was apparently out to get Pantages (although many say that the whole story was fabricated to add to the mystery of Alexander). Following work as a faro dealer, an assayer of gold, a cashier and a psychic (telling prospectors where they could find gold), Claude gave his first stage performance in 1898 (aged 18). It was not until returning to Seatlle in 1902, however, that Claude decided to make a career as a magician and he took the name Alexander the Great (after his friend) and started performing in vaudeville as a stage illusionist.



o add the sense of theatre and mysticism in his stage act, he began wearing a jewelled turban, Oriental-garb, and performed with his crystal ball as 'Alexander The Man Who Knows' - his act presented in a quasi-Oriental setting with lavish costuming for himself, and several female assistants. He promoted his psychic act as a form of mind - reading and could achieve the most remarkable display the world had ever seen. He also performed as a psychic "Astro" (to distance himself from his stage act), earning more money than he could from stage performances. He married again in Lillian Marion, who would become an 1915 to integral part of his show and they were to stay together for 14 years before she would file for divorce. His show at the time consisted of audience members giving Alexander sealed questions, which he amazingly answered from the stage (fans of Derren would have seen him do precisely this type of routine in one of his own shows). Alexander's mind-reading show became an instant hit and at the height of his career, he sold out theatres across the United States and Canada for weeks at a time. He made millions from box office receipts, and having the foresight to side-sell, made even more from the sale of books, crystal balls, and related merchandise (setting up a mail order business with six full time employees sending merchandise out). He travelled the world, and counted among his friends such show-business luminaries as Alexander Pantages, John Considine, Rudolph Valentine, and Clara Bow. One of his strengths was understanding marketing, and Alexander was at the forefront of poster designs to promote his stage acts. Some of his designs and concepts were quite masterful, even detailing like adding eastern words to the bottom of the posters to add further mysticism, along with giving himself a darker 'eastern' complexion. His posters are still very much in demand.

Depending on the references you read, Alexander had between eight and twelve marriages, including marrying one woman twice and also being married to two women at the same time. He married the first of his wives, Jessie Cullen, in 1902 (divorcing in 1903) and tried to develop an act to rival Houdini's popular and successful escape act. His second marriage was to Ethel Lyman, whom he met when she was only 14 years old.

Fate would play a significant part in much of Alexander's life. A chance call to leave his hotel in San Francisco early one morning saved his life when the hotel was destroyed in an earthquake as he crossed the street; and it was following a blizzard which stopped trains transporting his show, and leading to potential disaster, that one of his assistants suggested he simply do his short mind-read set as the main act. Despite his reluctance, he had little choice in the matter and the success of the 'propless' show surprised even Alexander. His career never looked back and now in his mid-thirties, he discarded the large props and relied on his tremendous skills as a showman to put over an act of mind-reading, taking much inspiration (or simply copying) from other top mentalists at the time including Anna Eva Fay and Sammi Baldwin. Despite already being married (and now with a 5 year old son) he married his third wife, 17 year old Della Martell in 1907 and returned to San Francisco to act as a psychic, knowing he would have plenty of customers seeking to speak with lost ones from the earthquake the previous year.


In terms of innovation, it was his use of electronic transmitting devices in the 1920's that really catch the imagination. Using his turban to hide earpieces he could carry out quite extraordinary feats of mind-reading that had never been seen before. He suffered from bad nerves before every show in case the electronics failed (so nothing has changed in this regard!). Interestingly his show featured many straight magic effects such as using a nest of boxes and vanishing cane, which, as many modern day successful mentalist would agree, are a fine way to add some colour and diversity to their mind-reading act. He would also perform Asrah, the Double Box trick and the Cabinet Box and one of his favourite and most successful illusions was Spirit Painting, whereby he would ask local politicians, distinguished community leaders and doctors (all whom could not advertise) to pay to have their picture appear at every show in the Spirit Painting.

In his early 40s, he authored many books and wrote under the name "C. Alexander." In 1921 he wrote and published The Life And Mysteries Of The Celebrated Dr. Q (also known as The Dr. Q. Book). Alexander also operated a publishing house, the C. Alexander Publishing Company in Los Angeles, California. His company released his own pro-spiritualist and New Thought material, including a multi-volume series called 'The Inner Secrets of Psychology' and a booklet for his clients called 'Personal Lessons, Codes, and Instructions for Members of the Crystal Silence League'. Interestingly he would send the Narell twins out to libraries where he was performing to research and steal pages form psychology texts and this formed the basis of his own book. He often ended shows saying 'someday psychology will be taught in schools' much to the disbelief of his audiences.


It is reported that Alexander earned around four million dollars during his relatively short career (equivalent to around £150-200 million in today's money). He dominated the stage for nearly a decade before retiring in 1924, at the age of 43, the richest man in vaudeville, spending much of his time at his retreat, hunting and fishing and taking photos of nude women (a hobby from which he made a further \$40,000 selling the images to various calendar companies).



HOW TO READ PEOPLE'S MINDS? I FEEL LIKE I CAN!

Most of the people like that someone else suggests them what is going in his or her mind. Such activities attract everybody. And many people have the ability to read the minds of others. Some people have such qualities God gifted, and some develop them with a little bit effort and struggle.

IT SEEMS IMPOSSIBLE

If someone says to me that he or she can read my mind, initially I will not believe. Obviously, it looks impossible. If possible, then it will be strenuous. It's our general opinion that only psychologists are trained for such activities. No doubt they are properly trained, but common people can also achieve it. But it demands that one remains to stick to one decision and keep on struggling.

NATURAL MIND READERS

To read the mind of others, we should be a keen observer. We should observe the expressions and thoughts of others. We should be sharp in guessing about the feelings. Sometimes, in the beginning, we may be wrong, but with time and practice, we will become an expert become your nature to focus.

SKILLS NEEDED TO BE DEVELOPED(FOR BEGINNERS)

1. CLEAR UP YOUR MIND

To read the mind of others, first of all, make yourself tension free. Clear up your mind of all kinds of anxieties and disturbances. Perceive everything in your environment.

2. OPEN UP YOUR SPIRIT

Apart from clearing up mind another important step is to be available at that time. By availability, I mean that all your attention should be towards that person not somewhere else. Your mental state and inner being should be in peace. For attaining peace, you can take exercise (yoga). You can do it by yourself at home if you can't take exercise because of some reason. For this sit in a separate room in complete silence and concentrate on nature. You will feel a strange power in the environment. If you keep on practicing with the time, you will learn how to focus on life and feelings or emotions of a person. And will become your nature to focus.

3. SEEING AND NOT SEEING

Concentrate on a person for few seconds and make a picture of his whole body, the way he is behaving and posing everything should be in your mind. You should have knowledge of other things in the surrounding either it is a chair on which he is sitting, table or a wall behind the man. You should not confuse the personality of a person with the surrounding. There should be a boundary between the two.

4. Focus on the Person

Now again focus on a person. Look into his eyes for about 15 seconds. Don't look for a long time because it may cause uneasiness. Make a picture of his eyes and face in your mind. Now you have to start the process of mind reading. Completely focus on the picture in your mind in complete quietness.

5. Begin to Talk with the Person

Choose any topic related to his occupation, home or any other and let's start to talk with him. It will help you to guess what is going in his mind. It will fill your mind with the variety of thoughts. Don't ignore your sixth sense and tell him what comes to your mind.

SOME OTHER WAYS

When you have become perfect in judging the emotions and thoughts of the others you can use some other tricks to give a broad view of what's going in the mind of others.

1. EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE

If you are aware of the person to whom you are talking, then you can share his feelings either he is sad or happy and can ask the reason for such feelings. If he is depressed, you can suggest him the ways by which he can reduce his grief. And it will be fruitful to enhance your skills.

2. YOU SHOULD BE A GOOD LISTENER

When you talk to the person, you should be entirely involved in the conversation. You should focus on what he is saying and what not. In some situations, silence speaks more than words. Your interest will help you to find out what's going in his mind.


3. Consider Feelings

Today we are so involved in our lives that we give no value to our emotions. That is the reason we can't understand others. Most of the experts say that more we respond to our feelings more, we will be able to consider the feelings of others.

INTERPRETATION

Initially, it seems difficult, but practice makes it possible. If you are a master in reading other minds, then don't use it in the negative perspective. Use it to help the people.





TOUCH HEAD READ MIND TRICK

ere, you are just asked to write any number you like on a paper and keep it secret so that the mentalist doesn't see it. Now, he is going to read your mind by touching your head and get to read the number from your mind. And the number he gives is right!

TRICK EXPLAINED

Here, what happens is that the mentalist will choose to "read" someone who is really close to him especially his buddies. This way they are going to really connect. Now for the "reading the number from his mind", he will just listen to it from his friend's body through the point of contact, the head, and take note of the number of times they clench their teeth. If he clenches subconsciously three times, the number is 3.


